

Three easy steps and you are done. We take care of the rest.

1. Register with ImmTrac2 by gathering your family's official immunization records.
2. Complete the ImmTrac2 "Adult Consent Form" (stock no. F11-13366) and the ImmTrac2 "Disaster Information Retention Consent Form" (stock no. F11-12956).
3. Submit both completed ImmTrac2 forms and copies of your immunization records by email at ImmTrac2@dshs.texas.gov, mail to DSHS Immunization Section at the address listed on the forms, or deliver to a health care provider authorized to access ImmTrac2.

Once registered, your complete immunization history is available to you and your health care provider anywhere in the state, when you need it.
